



Expression of Interest (EOI) - Selection of Vendors for Development of E-Learning Content

Issued by: **Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC)**

1. Introduction

Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC) is a national-level sector skill council for the Textile and Handloom Sector by the National Skill Development Corporation. It is an Awarding Body approved by the National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET) under the aegis of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, GoI, for the textile sector, Pan India, for the entire value chain from fibre to fabric, including Handlooms, recycled and technical textiles.

The purpose of this EOI is to empanel vendors capable of producing high-quality, demonstrational, and LMS-ready digital modules for vocational courses in the textile and handloom sector, thereby strengthening access to technology-enabled skilling.

2. Scope of Work

Vendors are expected to undertake end-to-end development of e-learning content for specified job roles:

- Two Shaft Handloom Weaver (TSC/Q7303), Version 4.0
- Hank Dyer (TSC/Q7201), Version 4.0

The scope includes:

- Instructional design aligned with NOS/QP requirements
- Script writing, storyboarding, and content structuring
- Demonstrational video production (multi-angle, process-driven)
- Multimedia asset creation (animations, graphics, assessments)
- LMS integration (SCORM-compliant packaging, testing, and quality assurance)
- Knowledge checks and recap modules

3. Eligibility Criteria

Vendors must demonstrate:

- Minimum 3 years of experience in instructional design, multimedia content development, and LMS integration
- Proven track record of at least 3 similar projects in vocational/technical training
- Availability of qualified instructional designers, video production teams, and technical staff
- Ability to deliver content in Hindi, with technical terminology appropriately integrated

4. Deliverables

- SCORM-compliant e-learning modules for each job role
- Not less than 175 to 180 minutes of content per course, with 30% structured e-learning and 70% demonstrational videos



- Integrated knowledge checks, assessments, and recap sections
- LMS-ready packages tested for compatibility with TSC’s portal and mobile application

5. Timeline

The course must be completed within **6-7 weeks**, with milestones as follows:

- Week 1–2: Script writing, instructional design, and final approvals (March 31st 2026)
- Week 4-5: Video production and editing (April 30th 2026)

- Week 7: Final validation and delivery (15th May 2026)

6. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated on:

- Technical expertise (50%)
- Past experience and portfolio (30%)
- Financial proposal (20%)

7. Submission Guidelines

Interested vendors must submit:

- Company profile and legal registration documents
- Technical proposal (approach, methodology, team composition)
- Financial proposal (detailed cost break-up per course)
- Samples of past work (preferably vocational/technical training modules)

8. Terms & Conditions

- Intellectual Property Rights will rest jointly with TSC and its partners.
- Vendors must adhere to NSQF standards and TSC’s quality assurance framework.

- Confidentiality of project data and information must be maintained.
